Initial Landing State
 When a visitor first visits the site, they will only see the global header, an intro message and a simple form asking the visitor to enter the code that was found on a rock.

A) Header
 The header will likely just be text but some other navigation or CTAs might be added later.

B) Intro Message
 The intro message must efficiently explain to the visitor the purpose of the project. Again, some linkage might exist in this content leading the visitor to 60bpm.com where other examples can be seen, but we want to focus on keeping the person here and converting.

C) Code Submission Form
 The code submission form will only ask for the code found on the back of the stone the person found. One field and submit.

NOTE: A note may be included indicating that only capital letters and numbers are acceptable. It may only introduce a possible bit of confusion to the visitor, so it may be omitted. Perhaps JavaScript can be used to capitalize the letters added to the field.

D) Stones In Circulation
 Stones that are currently in circulation are listed in a grid below the Code Submission Form. Each item in the grid will contain an image of the stone, along with information on the stone's distribution (e.g. location, date), and link to the Roaming Stones page on 60bpm.

Valid Code Entry
 Upon submitting a valid code, the visitor will be presented information on the stone as well as prompts to submit information on their own discovery and adding to the story.

A) CTA Header
 At the top of the page, a message will inform the visitor that information has been found about the stone and prompt the visitor to share information on this latest discovery.

B) Stone Image and Information
 A picture of and information about the stone will be displayed on the left side of the screen.

C) Previous Entries/Alternative Message
 If previous entries have been made for this stone, they will appear as a list on the right side of the screen. If no entries have been submitted, yet, a message indicating this is the first time the stone has been found will appear here.

D) Redundant CTA Footer
 Some variation of the CTA Header will appear at the bottom of the screen, just to be sure the visitor has seen the prompt to submit the discovery of the stone.

Anonymous Visit to the Page
If a normal site visitor lands here, the page will display a grid of all roaming stones along with any entries associated with them.

A) Page Content
The page content will be fed from the page content block and describe the project and the content on the page.

B) Grid Item w/ Entries
All grid items will contain a picture of the stone along with other pertinent information associated with it. If the grid item has entries associated with it, they will be listed below the image and information.

C) Entries Listing
The entries listing should be something that can be reused on the individual gallery listing of the stone. Ideally, the list could be placed in the content area of the gallery page.

D) Grid Item wo/ Entries
An “undiscovered stone” without any associate entries will simply have a message indicating that it’s not yet been found.

Visit Via https://60bpm.rocks/ Validation
A visitor to the 60bpm.rocks site who enter a valid code will be presented with CTAs to submit their own story. These CTAs will send POST data to this page which should re-validate the discovery and present the visitor with a form to submit their story.

A) Page Content
This page content will cater to visitors coming from 60bpm.rocks expecting to submit information. It will be managed via custom fields on the page.

B) Stone Image and Information
A picture of and information about the stone will be displayed on the left side of the screen.

C) Entries/Alternative Message
If entries have been submitted for this stone, they will appear as a list on the left side of the screen below the stone image and information. If no entries have been submitted, yet, a message indicating that the stone hasn’t been found will appear here.

D) Submission Form
A form for submitting a discovery will appear on the right side of the page. Messaging should be clear that the email address is optional and will not be shared with the public.

NOTE: In mobile view, the form should appear at the top of the page along with another instance of the image. Be sure to test whether or not a 5MB+ file size can be uploaded through the form, otherwise remove the image upload field.
